# NOTE TO SELF:

#### **REMINDERS!**

**Manure -** All manure **MUST** be removed from the yards and carpark area. Please dispose of it in the feed bags required or take it home. Manure is **NOT** to be dumped around the trees!

**Daylight savings -** Daylight savings starts this Sunday (rally day), ensure you put your clocks forward an hour Saturday night so you arrive on time to the rally.

Wow, Daylight Savings is here once again so don't forget to change your clocks for Rally on Sunday and arrive on time.....Clocks go forward by 1 hour before you go to bed Saturday night and you will feel like you are getting up extra early on Sunday morning. ## **MPPC Uniform Policy:**

MPPC Uniform must be worn to each rally unless otherwise notified in the instances we have a themed rally where other items of clothing can be worn. Uniform must be worn by both mounted & unmounted riders. Correct uniform is part of Gear Check and points awarded in Gear Check are counted towards the End of Year 'Best Presented' Awards.

Regardless of time of year, an **approved helmet and riding boots** must be worn. Approved Riding Helmets must meet one of the following Standards:

- Australia New Zealand standard 3838 Marked SAI Global
- Australia New Zealand standard ARB HS 2012 (racing helmets) Marked SAI Global
- American standard ASTM F1163 Marked SEI or SNELL E2001
- European standard (new, interim) VG01.040 (2014-12) (Note that new helmets may carry both the EN1384 & VG1 marks)

If your Helmet does not meet one of these standards, it is deemed unsafe to use at Pony Club – if in doubt please present the helmet at the office before riding. Insurance is voided for any accidents where an unapproved helmet is worn by the rider.

Winter Uniform – Between April and September (inclusive)

Jodhpurs – White/Beige/Cream range of colours – Dark coloured Jodhpurs can ONLY be worn by Unmounted Riders

White Collared Shirt

Brown Pony Club Tie (in stock to purchase at Office)

Red Pony Club Woollen Jumper (in stock to purchase at Office)

Pony Club Badge – to be worn at the bottom of the 'V' neck of the jumper

Summer Uniform – Between October and March (Inclusive)

Jodhpurs – White/Beige/Cream range of colours – Dark coloured Jodhpurs can ONLY be worn by Unmounted Riders

MPPC Polo Top (in Stock to purchase at Office)

Medical Armbands are no longer a requirement of approved uniform, however, if you have an armband with your details on it, why not wear it so if anything does happen, people around you can check for any important information.

Optional Items such as MPPC Hoodie, Track Pants, Winter Jacket are available for purchase at the office

#### Did you know?

In dressage whips are allowed to be carried in your tests. For grades 1 to 3 the whip can be up to 1200mm long including the lash but for grades 4 and 5 they must be no longer than 750mm including the flap. All grades can carry a whip no longer than 750mm including the flap in cross country, showjumping, flat teams, musical rides and show ring ridden classes. Whips are not to be used in games events.

# **Uniform:**

#### Riders please note **SUMMER** uniform is to be worn at the rally

Winter uniform is the white shirt, brown tie, red woollen jumper, white/cream/banana jodhpurs and riding boots. It is important for riders to be in the correct gear at rallies.

**If unmounted pony club uniform is still required** however dark jodhpurs are acceptable. Clean riding boots and pony club top must be worn.

New members are allowed a reasonable time to arrange the gear & we acknowledge that at times we may not have all sizes in stock.

Jumping vests are recommended at MPPC for jumping lessons.



#### Pony Club Top Tips!



- Riders must sign in the morning of the rally with their pony club books
- Please stay for lunchtime or end of rally meeting as important information is shared during it
- Ensure your horse has access to fresh water and hay throughout the day during breaks
- Ride at a sensible speed through the car park area
  - Riders must be accompanied by an adult whilst at Pony Club
  - Horses must not be tied to floats that are not attached to cars
  - All manure must be removed from the yards and carpark area and either taken home or placed in the available feed bags
  - Summer uniform is to be worn during daylight savings time and
    Winter uniform when it is not daylight savings
