Best three final overall scores of the team will be used to determine the overall placings. The team with the lowest score will be the team that wins.

PRIZES:

- PCV HT: Winning team receives perpetual trophy, rug for each member of winning team, sashes from 1st to 6th place. Prize for individual best dressage in each ring.

- OPEN HT: Rug for 1st, sashes from 1st to 6th place. Prize for individual best dressage.

- PCV CT: Rug for 1st place, sashes from 1st to 6th place. Prize for individual best dressage.

Conditions of Entry: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of the following conditions;

1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.

2. Before Riding - ALL Open Sections Competitors must complete and submit a Liability Declaration form available on the day. A \$15 Participation Fee is also payable in addition to the entry fee UNLESS proof of current financial membership of PCV, EV/EA, AHS, SHCA, AERA, HRCAV, an interstate Pony Club or can provide proof of Personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. If you are required to pay the \$15.00 Day Participation Fee, you must also complete and submit a Day Participation Waiver form.

3. **Before Riding - All PCV Sections Competitors** must present their 2019/20 and 2020/21 Grading Cards to office for inspection

4. Gear check for ALL competitors is required 20 minutes before each phase.

5. All Competitors must wear "Standards Approved" complying Helmets. Complying Helmets are: AS/NZS 3838 (AU), ASTMF1163 (USA), PAS015 (UK), VGI (EUROPE), EN1384 (EUROPE) only up to and incl. 2015 (if made in 2016 not acceptable unless also complies with VGI) Spot checks of helmets will occur and incorrect helmets will incur elimination.

6. **Competitor numbers** - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers and supply body numbers which must be **worn for all phases.**

7. All Pony Club competitors must be graded by their DC for the grade they have entered.

8. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any section or competition; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

9. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCV Handbook of Bylaws multiple horse rules.

10. Horses must be at least age four; no stallions, colts or rigs.

11. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.

12. Dogs are prohibited at this event.

13. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws.

14. No Lunging permitted on the grounds

15. Riders under 8 years old are NOT permitted to compete in Horse Trials.

16. All Competitors must be prepared to supply a volunteer for this competition

17. All refunds are subject to a \$10 administration fee. There shall be no refunds after 19th of February unless notified prior to ride time to office@eventsecretary.com.au and a valid veterinary or doctor's medical certificate is provided within 7 days notification of scratching.
18. Neither the organising committee of this competition, nor the PCV, accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, Competitors, ground spectators or any other person or property.
