CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

Entry is conditional upon acceptance of the following conditions:

- 1. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
- 2. Entry fee is \$72.00 for Pony Club sections and \$72.00 for open sections. Please note there will be no refunds after closing date being Thursday 31st of January 2021` without valid veterinary certificate supplied within 7 days of notification. \$20.00 admin fee applies for all refunds.
- 3. Before Riding ALL unofficial EA competitors must complete and submit a Liability Declaration Form (available on the day). A \$15 Participation Fee is also payable in additional to the entry fee UNLESS proof of current financial membership of PCV, EV/EA, AHS, AHSA, AERA, HRCAV, an interstate Pony Club or can provide proof of Personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. If you are required to pay the \$15 Day Participation Fee, you must also complete and submit a Day Participation Waiver form (at the bottom of the Liability Declaration form).
- Before Riding All PCV Competitors must present their 2019/20 and 2020/21 Grading Cards to the office for inspection.
- 5. **Gear Check** for <u>ALL</u> Competitors is required 20 minutes before their first dressage test.
- Gear check will be using "Pure Dressage" Gear check Rules.
- 7. All competitors must wear "Standards Approved" complying Helmets.

 Complying Helmets are: AS/NZS 3838 (AU). ASTMF1163 (USA), PAS105 (UK), VGI (EUROPE), only up to and incl. 2015 (if made in 2016 not acceptable unless also complies with VGI). Spot Checks

of helmets will occur and incorrect helmets will incur elimination.

- 8. All Pony Club dressage tests taken from 'PCAV Dressage Tests', effective Feb 2013 available from the PCAV website.
- 9. All Unofficial EA dressage test taken from the 2019 Equestrian Australia tests – found on the EA website
- 10. **Test calling permitted** for all tests.
- 11. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide or combine any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- 12. All Pony Club Competitors must be graded by their DC for the dressage grade they have entered.
- 13. Competitors may ride more than one horse subject to the conditions of PCV Handbook of By-Laws Multiple Horse Rule 34.8.
- 14. A horse or pony, if ridden by one or more competitor, may compete in NO more than 4 dressage tests.
- 15. Pony Club Competitors and unofficial **EA riders to supply own numbers.** (Can be bridle or saddle pad numbers).
- 16. Queries, protests, horse abuse and doping rules as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.
- 17. No stallions, colts or rigs. No horses or ponies under 4 years of age. **LUNGING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
- 18. Dogs are permitted but <u>MUST</u> BE ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES.
- 19. Times will be emailed to all competitors by the Thursday night prior to the event and will be posted on the Mornington Peninsula Pony Club Facebook page.
- 20. Neither the organising committee of this competition, nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, competitors, ground spectators or any other person or property.
